Main Aims

- Making sense of the research world
- Promoting the use of research-based evidence in healthcare organisations

How it works

- Funding from CLAHRC for 1 day a week for a year (via backfill)
- Fellows carry out a project under supervision of a CLAHRC senior researcher
- Attendance at monthly teaching workshops and bi-monthly action learning sets (1st Thurs of every month)

Who the fellowship is for:

It is aimed at **all clinicians, health and social care practitioners, and managers across the East of England**, who would like to: work at the interface of research and practice; develop an understanding of the research environment; and develop skills in research methodology, service redesign and change management. Identify a **supervisor & write proposal** ready for applying (support is available for this)

Submit your application to the CLAHRC manager by the closing date

If shortlisted, **attend an interview** (end of September)
