For Pre-doctoral, Doctoral and Post-Doctoral Awards

Pre-doctoral Clinical Academic Fellowships

Enables registered healthcare professionals to undertake Masters level academic training and to prepare an application for a doctoral fellowship whilst maintaining clinical practice.

Closing date: 11th April 2018

Clinical Doctoral Research Fellowships

Enables graduate clinicians with some research experience and aspirations for a clinical academic career to obtain a PhD whilst continuing to practice and develop professionally.

Closing date: 27th April 2018

Clinical Lectureships

Enables recent doctoral graduates and early postdoctoral researchers to undertake a joint clinical academic role whilst becoming independent clinical academic researchers.

Closing date: 19th April 2018

Senior Clinical Lectureships

Enables outstanding individuals who are currently independent researchers to undertake a senior clinical academic role, whilst progressing as a clinical academic leader.

Closing date: 19th April 2018
